Name:

Role: First Lord of the Admiralty and later Minister of Munitions.

Hint: During the second World War this man was Prime Minster and famously said "Never in the field of human conflict was so

much owed by so many to so few."



Name:

Role: UK Secretary of State.

Hint: He played a crucial role in raising a large volunteer army in Britain.



Name:

Role: Heir to the Austro-Hungarian empire who married a 'commoner'. **Hint:** His assassination along with his wife is considered the catalyst for

the Great War.



Name:

Role: British General and Commander in Chief.

Hint: Best known for his involvement in planning the unsuccessful

Somme offensive of 1916.





Name:

Role: German fighter pilot with the Imperial German Army Air Service.

Hint: Also known as the Red Baron due to his success in the air.



Name:

Role: British officer posted to the Middle East.

Hint: He played a key role in fermenting the Arabs to revolt against the Ottoman Empire, a film was made of this person.



Name:

Role: The last Russian Emperor.

Hint: Approved Russia's entry into the First World War.



Name:

Role: A war poet who as a soldier was awarded the Military Cross

for bravery.

Hint: Famous for his poem 'Dulce et decorum est'.

Role: Military dog which served with the 102nd Infantry Regiment in the trenches in France.

Hint: The most decorated war dog said to have been promoted to

sergeant through combat!
